MEDICAL KIT LIST

Plasters, bandages

Antiseptic spray

Scissors and tweezers

Thermometre

Sterile needle and syringe kit

Insect repellent!

Insect bite cream (some bites are unavoidable)

lodine or water disinfection tablets

Painkillers

Travel sickness medication is often a good idea

Antimalarial drugs

Re-hydration sachets

Antifungals

Antibiotics (such as Cyprofloxacin – ask your doctor)

Talcum powder

Alcohol-based hand-sanitiser

Any medication you regularly take and the prescription, if applicable

Appropriate travel or medical insurance

Please ensure, prior to departure, that you are not allergic or have any adverse reactions to any medication you intend to take with you. Particularly, talk to your doctor about antibiotics (gut infections are not uncommon and easily treated) and about which are the most appropriate antimalarial tablets for you (bear in mind only Atovaguine [eq Malarone], Mefloquine [eq Lariam], and Doxycycline are effective in this area of Ecuador).

GENERAL KIT LIST

High factor suncream – even if you don't usually burn: we're on the equator!

Mosquito net

Hammock (optional)

Sleeping bag or blanket, esp. if intending to sleep in a hammock

Long sleeved tops and trousers - think fast-drying and comfortable

Fleece or jumper

Hot weather clothes – think fast-drying and comfortable

Set of casual wear (e.g. if in town at either end of your stay)

Clothes-washing soap – you'll do your own laundry

Sunhat or cap

Swim-wear

Towel - think fast-drying

Light impermeable jacket

Flip-flops / sandals

Flashlight - a good one! Minimum 70 lumens recommended

Head lamp - not strictly necessary, but highly recommended

Rubber boots – walking shoes or trainers also recommended)

Binoculars are a good idea

Ziplock bags and silica gels for storing electronic equipment or even clothes

You will want to bring a camera!

Personal toiletries (soap and whatnot), ideally biodegradable

US-style plug adaptors

Water bottle / canteen - 1 or 1.5 L capacity; camel-packs are not recommended

Day pack

Snacks or thinks you can foresee wanting, you won't get these in the jungle
